To continue this unique public benefit, we need committed people who are willing to give 2-3 hours or more per week, this would normally be during the day to early evening. You would be helping to provide a vital service for those whose financial stability is affected by our uncertain times.

You can help in lots of different ways

- Become a financial administrator dealing with savings transactions and loan applications.
- Help with office organisation, e.g. filing, stationery, data inputting, answering the phone and emails.
- Update and refresh our website.
- Use your skills in publicity and design.
- Join our Treasury Team. We need long -term volunteers to help with our accounting.
- Join our Supervisory Committee to help with internal auditing.

Training can be given for all these roles, and we would welcome anyone with suitable skills.

Who can get involved?

Anyone 18 or over is welcome. You don't have to be a member of Watford Credit Union to become a Volunteer.
